Project Type: Vegetation Management

This application includes provisions related to aquatic vegetation management within the Tri-Dam Project. Vegetation management activities are limited and regulated to protect water quality, habitat, and recreational use. Approved methods may include bottom barrier mats and other Tri-Dam authorized control measures. All activities must comply with applicable federal, state, and local regulations.

Check one:

Bottom Barrier Mat Application

- Bottom barrier mats are allowed for the control of aquatic nuisance vegetation such as Eurasian watermilfoil and Brazilian elodea (*Egeria densa*).
- Mats are limited to a maximum area of **800 square feet** and must be placed only in areas necessary to maintain navigability (e.g., under docks or within access paths).
- Vegetation along the natural shoreline should be preserved where feasible.
- Mats must be installed within the applicant's property boundaries unless otherwise approved by Tri-Dam.
- A site plan must be submitted showing the proposed location and dimensions of the mats.
- Herbicide or chemical treatments are **not authorized** under this application.
- Permittees are responsible for ongoing maintenance and monitoring of installed mats to ensure they do not create navigation or safety hazards.
- Poorly maintained or abandoned mats may be subject to removal at the owner's expense.

Mechanical Harvesting

- Mechanical harvesting uses equipment to cut aquatic vegetation below the water surface. This method may be used in larger areas where plant growth is more extensive. This method requires authorization from applicable regulatory agencies.

Diver Assisted Suction Harvesting (D.A.S.H.)

- Diver-Assisted Suction Harvesting uses a diver-operated suction system to remove plants directly from the lakebed. This method removes plants at the root base while collecting plant fragments through a suction hose. This method requires authorization from applicable regulatory agencies.

Hand-Pulling (No application is required)

- Please Note: Hand pulling may be used to remove aquatic vegetation in small areas or confined spaces where other methods are not practical. Plants should be carefully removed from the root base and contained to prevent fragments from spreading. Hand-pulling of aquatic weeds that does not involve excavation, mechanized equipment, or disturbance of the shoreline or lakebed generally does not require a Tri-Dam permit. Activities must be limited to manual removal only and all plant material must be removed from the reservoir and properly disposed of upland.
